IMPORTANT SMP VOLUNTEER NOTES:

- SMP Volunteer Events are open to ALL Active Duty, Dependents, DoD and their guests.
- Event registration recommended at smp.mccscherrypoint.com or event website, if listed.
- Please fill out and submit your SMP POV Volunteer Log electronically at smp.mccscherrypoint.com under the volunteer tab. Hard copies of POV logs can be picked up at the Roadhouse Recreation Center Front Desk and either dropped off at the Roadhouse Rec Center or emailed to ombcherryointsmp@usmc-mccs.org. LOA's will be processed once volunteer hours are confirmed.
- LOA's are available for Active Duty volunteers and will be completed once volunteer hours are confirmed.
- SMP website has the most up to date volunteer opportunities.
- Please dress for weather and bring water, snacks or any sun protection you may need.
- No USMC, Federal or SMP endorsement implied.

JULY VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES:

- **City of Havelock Freedom Fest (Monday 7/4)** Come help with the City of Havelock Freedom Fest on July 4th. Volunteers needed to help set up, tear down, run games and direct traffic. Please meet at the City Park at 3pm and should run until 9pm. There will be fireworks at sundown and the 2nd MAW band will be performing.
- **DownEastCon Catch '22 (Saturday 7/9) (POV ONLY)** Come out to help with the Catch '22 model building event. The event will have scale model builders and vendors of hobby materials from the surrounding region for a time of fun and getting to know others.
